- ◆ Linking you in with local parent support groups and forums.

Statements of Special Educational Need (SEN) have changed into Education, Health and Care Plans (EHC) for children and young people 0-25 years. This brings education, health and social care needs into one single legal document. Our Independent Supporters who are based across Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly are friendly, professional and trained to support you through the process.

They can support you to:

- ◆ Understand the Local Offer and process for EHCP's
- ◆ Put together the one page profile required for the plan
- ◆ Transfer a statement of SEN or Learning Disability Assessment (LDA) into an EHC plan.

Independent Supporters can work with parents and young people who are new to the system or who previously had a LDA.

They can provide confidential support to young people age 16+ independently if requested and liaise across a range of services on your behalf to help gather information required for the EHC plan.
