TOPIC: Where I Live

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be learning: Why the word 'God' special to Christians. We will be exploring enquiry questions, such as

What does the word 'God' mean?

Which people believe in God?

Which people believe God is the creator of everything?

What is amazing about the world?

What do Christians say about God as creator?

What is the story that Christians use to think about the creator?
What do Christians (and other people) think about the world and
how we should treat it?

SPIRITUALITY

We will be exploring where we belong, within the context of Cornwall, St. Ives and our local area.

MATHS

We will be developing a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number. We will be learning to subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 6. We will be learning to compare quantities up to 5 and above in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity. We will also be learning to describe a familiar route and discuss routes and locations, using words like 'in front of' and 'behind'.

EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

We will be: using drawing, collage, role play, small world and construction to represent features and places in our local environment and to recreate to stories of local significance. We will be exploring different materials and their textures, learning how to join different materials and choosing and using materials to develop our own ideas.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

We will be learning to: use new vocabulary. Articulate our ideas and experiences in well-formed sentences. Ask questions to find out more and to check we understand what has been said to us.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be learning about: key features, people and places of interest in our local area, how to draw information from simple maps and how make our own simple maps. We will be using all our senses to explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties, including natural materials found in our local environment, and using a wide range of vocabulary to talk about our experiences.

PHYSCIAL DEVELOPMENT

(Gross Motor) We will be learning to: use a range of ball skills, including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming. We will be developing confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball.

(Fine Motor) We will be learning: to use a range of tools (such as scissors, pencils and knives and forks) competently, safely and confidently.

WRITING

We will be learning to: Form lower-case and capital letters correctly, spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s. We will also be learning to write short sentences with words with known letter-sound correspondences and re-read what we have written to check that it makes sense.

READING

We will be learning about: non-fiction texts and how to use them to retrieve information, including facts about our local area. We will be listening to stories of local interest, including fiction stories, myths and legends.

In Read, Write Inc, we will be learning to: Read Set 2 sounds; blend Set 1 and 2 sounds to read green words and recognise some common exception (red) words.

PSED

In Spring 1, we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe, including road safety, safety in the home, stranger danger and online safety.

In Spring 2, we will be learning about our rights and responsibilities at school, where we life and in the wider world.
