Plant a seed or bulb. Nurture it. Keep a record of its growth. You could do this through photos, drawings or measurements.	Explore different ways to make 10 eg adding two or more numbers together, taking away. Use resources to help you. How many different ways can you find?	Make a miniature garden in a small container. You could use real or artificial plants; moss, grass seed or fabric for grass; sand or pebbles for paths, lolly sticks to create fences, sheds etc. For more ideas see:  google images miniature gardens made by young children - Google  Search
Persevere to learn a new skill eg riding your bike without stabilisers, fastening a zip, hopping on one leg, folding your clothes. Remember to keep on trying when you find it hard, don't give up, be proud of yourself!	Visit a garden centre, public gardens, allotment or orchard. What kind of plants can you find there? How are the plants there being cared for? Do some plants look healthier than others? Why do you think this might be? What is your favourite thing about the place you visited?	Look at a photo, drawing or painting that shows you what St. Ives was like in the past. What do you notice? Can you spot anywhere or anything you recognise? How has St. Ives changed over time?
Learn to write numerals 0 – 5 or 0 – 10. Ask an adult to check if you have written your numbers the right way round!	Write a postcard to your class.
