# CHILLI CHALLENGE HOMEWORK

Choose your homework from the menu below. the peri-ometer shows you the level of challenge. You need to reach a minimum of ten points to achieve your homework target for the half term!

Make a model of your house or a house you know using junk modelling materials.	Draw a map of where you live. Are there any things of interest close to your house? E.g. bus stop, phone box, corner shop, church etc.	Follow a recipe to bake biscuits that you can share with friends or family.
Draw, paint or take a picture of your house and label it. Can you hear the sounds in the words and write them down. E.g. d-door, w-window.	Do you know anyone that lives outside of Cornwall, or even a different country? With help from grown-ups at home, find where they live on a map. Discuss what is the same or different about where they live.	Does anyone you know have a job that helps to keep others safe and healthy, e.g. doctor, police, fire officer, soldier etc. Ask them about their job or research a similar profession that you can talk about in a few weeks in PSHE.
Create a dance to a song of your choice. Think about how fast or slow the music sounds and make up dance moves to match.	Play a maths game on <a href="#">Early Years Maths - Topmarks Search</a>  (Filter subject and age group to maths/EYFS)	Read a story with a loved one. Think about who the main characters are and describe them. For example, are they kind, brave or nervous? Tall or short? Etc.
Write as many sounds as you can remember on a piece of paper. Remember to check they are formed correctly. (See letter formation sheet in your child's bag).	Go on a winter walk. Think about what you can see, hear, feel and smell. Can you collect any interesting objects?	Observe some exciting weather. Think about which clothes you need to wear to go outside in it and either draw a picture of yourself or take a photo wearing them.
