Chilli Challenge Take-away homework!

Choose your homework from the grid below. The peri-ometer shows you the level of challenge.

You need to reach a minimum of ten points to reach your homework target for each half term.

6 Points	Create your own medicine bottle as a cure for the Plague. What ingredients might you include? Create a 'recipe' and your bottle.	Create a model of the planets in our solar system (these could be 3D or 2D).	During the great plague people would eat lots of cured and preserved meats, as well as seasonal vegetables when possible. With help from your adults make your own soup using seasonal vegetables. You could also make your own bread to eat with this.
5 Points	The rubbish in London contributed to the impact of the Plague. Do you have a wonderful environment in which to live now? Complete a survey of litter or take pictures of lovely areas and any 'grot spots' within your local area. What could you do about it?	Keep a sky at night journal for a whole week. Draw a picture of the moon every night. Does it change over the course of the week? Why does it change?	Create a Venn diagram to show similarities and differences between the great plague and the Spanish flu pandemic.
4 Points	Design an information poster about staying healthy and hygienic. Could you make a slogan for washing your hands.	Write a poem describing what life was like in Britain during the plague.	Use the internet or books to collect ideas, facts and pictures about the Great Plague.
3 Points	Create a poster with the title 'staying safe online'. Include all your top tips for staying safe when using the internet.	Pretend you are a news reporter in 1666. Write a newspaper report. This could be handwritten or typed on the computer. Remember to make your newspaper report look old!	Create a history time-line of all the topics we have studied up to the plague (Egyptians, Tudors, Anglo-Saxons, Aztecs).
