## 27.4.23 – St Uny C of E Academy Uniform Update

Dear Parents & Carers,

Following on from our parent and pupil consultation regarding our school uniform, I am writing to provide you with information regarding future changes to our school uniform. Our aim is to ensure the St Uny



school uniform is more cost effective for parents and more comfortable for pupils as they enjoy their daily learning and activities. This will initially take place in KS1 and will extend to KS2 as detailed below.

### Key Stage 1:

From September 2023, we will be moving to St Uny C of E sweatshirts and white polo shirts.

### Key Stage 2:

The existing uniform will continue for KS2 pupils in September, whilst this is currently in stock. <u>Trophy Textiles have very kindly agreed to discount the price of these items to 50%</u>. Once the existing stock has been used up, the new sweatshirts will be available as pupils move to our new uniform. This will replace our current cardigans, school ties and shirts.

#### Next Steps:

We feel it is important to give lots of notice and to ensure the new uniform is available to order from the summer so parents can prepare for September. **There is no expectation for parents to replace existing uniform whilst current clothing fits their child.** New uniform can be ordered via Trophy Textiles as and when this is needed.

The existing grey trousers, shorts or skirt and black shoes will remain the same for all pupils. Girls will also still be able to wear a navy checked dresses in the summer if preferable. Our navy blue school colour will remain the same, meaning colours are also available in local supermarkets.
